# Irish Timber in Agriculture

- Traditional usage of Oak and Larch
- CCA treated timber in the 1970s
- Promise of 20 years

## CCA (Copper Chrome Arsenic) - No longer on the market

- Some material gave a long service life (in excess of 20 years)
- The majority of the material lasted approximately 7 to 20 years
- Unfortunately some of this product failed from 4- 5 years onwards
- Confidence Damaged

### Creosote - Limited to certain markets

- Agricultural Fencing
- Roadway Fencing
- Equine Fencing

30 year old Creosote Post & Rail
